Your task is to come up with one skill done well, and one area in which we could improve. On Thursday 17th June this will form the basis of our coaching session. This review will allow every field umpire to be involved and further both your personal and our group skills around what is expected when umpiring in the WRFL. We would encourage you to look at different aspects of skills such as set kick control, positioning, communication etc. We are not interested in free kicks but skills. However, you are welcome to question any free kick paid or not paid. We have chosen this game because only Dean has featured previously, and we have stated before that all umpires will be featured during the season. Again, this is an opportunity to improve on our skill as a group.
